## **CITY OF CHINO HILLS' YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM SEEKS APPLICANTS - DEADLINE APRIL 2<sup>nd</sup>**

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills is seeking applications for its 2018 Youth Scholarship and Summer Day Camp Scholarship Programs. Summer Day Camp Scholarships are available to children ages 6 to 12 and cover the total cost of the 9-week summer program. Youth Scholarships are open to children 17 years and under, and are designed to provide up to two summer recreation classes per child (maximum of \$500/family). The scholarship program helps economically-disadvantaged youth participate in the City's youth programs.

Scholarship funding is provided by the Chino Hills Community Foundation, which was formed in 2008 to support cultural, educational, and recreational projects in Chino Hills. Scholarships are provided on a first-come, first-served basis, based on funding availability and participant income eligibility.

Applications will be accepted from February 5<sup>th</sup> to April 2<sup>nd</sup>.
