CHINO HILLS POLICE DEPARTMENT HOSTS PUBLIC SAFETY FORUM WEDNESDAY, MARCH 14TH

Chino Hills, CA – The Chino Hills Police Department has scheduled a Chino Hills Public Safety Forum on Wednesday, March 14th from 6:30 – 8:00 p.m. at the Chino Hills Community Center, 14250 Peyton Drive. Regular community meetings are part of Captain Darren Goodman’s vision for increasing engagement with the community and providing the Police Department with opportunities to hear from stakeholders.

“Public safety is only as good as the participation of the public being served,” according to Captain Goodman. “Chino Hills is a very engaged community and that interaction helps our Department provide excellent police services.”

Police Department personnel will provide information about crime prevention measures, cannabis cultivation, package theft, and WeTip. Also on the agenda is the “Taking Back Our Community” initiative which the City of Chino Hills recently joined. This coalition of cities is dedicated to educating the public and improving law enforcement’s ability to address the unintended consequences and public safety threats occurring due to new legislation.
