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RESIDENTS INVITED TO JULY 18 WORKSHOP TO PROVIDE INPUT ON FAIR HOUSING STUDY

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills invites local residents to provide input relating to housing in Chino Hills by attending a workshop at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 18 at the Chino Hills Community Center, 14250 Peyton Drive, or by completing an online survey available at www.chinohills.org/CDBG. The opinions and perceptions of local residents are an important part of this study. Refreshments will be served and children are welcome. Persons who require special assistance to participate in this meeting should contact the Community Services Office, (909) 364-2710, at least 48 hours prior to the start of the meeting to enable the City to make reasonable arrangements. Translation services, including those for the hearing impaired, will be provided upon request.

The City is preparing a fair housing study, known formally as an Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice. The study, required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), will discuss patterns of race, housing, and poverty; access to opportunity; and housing barriers in the region. It will also outline strategies the City may take to improve housing choices for its residents. Project updates will be posted online at www.chinohills.org/CDBG, and a draft of the study will be available in early 2020.

The City of Chino Hills is also required to submit a multi-year Consolidated Plan and an Annual Action Plan describing community needs and funding priorities to HUD. These planning documents are submitted as a prerequisite to receiving funds under HUD's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program.

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
