Chino Hills, CA –Residents interested in serving on the Parks and Recreation Commission are invited to complete an application. Mayor Cynthia Moran will review the applications and nominate an individual to fill a vacancy created after Parks and Recreation Commissioner Bill Taylor submitted his resignation due to increased work responsibilities. Applications must be returned to the City Clerk’s Office on the second floor at City Hall, 14000 City Center Drive, by 4:00 p.m. on Friday, August 2.

The Parks and Recreation Commission meets on the third Wednesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. to review issues related to parks, recreation, community events, and programs. Commissioners work with community sports organizations and provide input to the design of park and recreation facilities.
