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CITY OF CHINO HILLS ADOPTS TEMPORARY POLICIES TO HELP BUSINESSES AND RESTAURANTS

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills has approved temporary policies to help restaurants and businesses facing significant economic impact due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Restaurants and retail food facilities are encouraged to contact the City to take advantage of a streamlined, simplified process, to provide additional seating outdoors in adjacent parking areas or patios. Staff is providing expedited processing for the no cost Outdoor Dining Patio permit. An application is available online at www.chinohills.org/OutdoorDining. In addition, permit fees for temporary banners and special retail business promotion events have been waived. The City Council also relaxed yard sale regulations temporarily waiving the limit of three yard sales per year, and dropping the permit requirement during the COVID-19 pandemic.

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
