COMMISSION APPLICATIONS SOUGHT

Chino Hills, CA – Recently-elected City Council Members Art Bennett and Cynthia Moran are seeking applications from Chino Hills residents who are interested in serving on the Planning, Parks and Recreation, and Public Works Commissions. Commission members serve a term that coincides with the term of their nominating Council Member. Terms of current appointees expired on November 30. Commissioners appointed by Council Members Bennett and Moran must reapply if they are interested in continuing their service. These appointees are Planning Commissioners Sheran Voigt and Patrick Hamamoto; Public Works Commissioners Mike Kleczko; and Parks and Recreation Commissioners Jennifer Holtkamp and Robert Gavela. Council Members Bennett and Moran have encouraged all to apply. Public Works Commissioner Bill McDonnell, an appointee of Art Bennett, no longer lives in Chino Hills and was recently recognized for his 24 years of service.

The application period begins on Tuesday, December 8. Applications will be available online at www.chinohills.org/CommissionApplication and at Chino Hills City Hall, 14000 City Center Drive, at the main reception desk on the second floor in the City Clerk's Lobby.

Interested persons should return a completed application to the Chino Hills City Clerk by 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, December 22, 2020. Interviews may be scheduled at the Council Members' discretion. Council Members expect to make their nominations at the January 12 City Council meeting. Members of the City Council must affirm the appointment. The new Commissioners' terms will be effective through the end of their appointing Council Member's term: November 30, 2024.

The Planning Commission meets on the first and third Tuesday of each month at 7 p.m. to review issues related to development and building and safety. The Commission also reviews site plans, amendments to the Development Code and General Plan, residential designs, design standards, and development standards.

The Parks and Recreation Commission meets on the third Wednesday of each month at 7 p.m. to review issues related to parks, recreation, community events, and programs. Commissioners work with community sports organizations and provide input to the design of park and recreation facilities.

The Public Works Commission meets on the first Wednesday of each month at 7 p.m. to review issues related to public safety, cable television, water, water rates, sewers, and roads. The Public Works Commission also considers traffic-related concerns such as stop signs, speed humps, and traffic signals.
