## **COVID-19 TESTING EVENTS OFFERED IN CHINO HILLS SATURDAYS - JANUARY 9 & 23; AND WEDNESDAYS – FEBRUARY 3 & 17**

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills has partnered with San Bernardino County Public Health and Fourth District County Supervisor Curt Hagman to offer free COVID-19 tests in Chino Hills. January testing dates are on Saturdays, January 9 and 23; and, February testing dates are on Wednesdays, February 3 and 17. (January dates have been rescheduled from previously publicized dates of January 6 and 20. Those dates are not available due to increase in testing needs in San Bernardino County.)

Tests will be conducted from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm inside the barn at the McCoy Equestrian & Recreation Center, 14280 Peyton Drive. Face coverings are required. A parent or guardian must accompany children under 18 years old.

COVID-19 testing is encouraged for everyone. No symptoms are required to get a COVID-19 test. Walk-ins will be accepted while supplies last. The County of San Bernardino will activate appointment registration for testing events approximately five to seven days before the event date. Visit [www.sbcounty.gov/dph/flu](http://www.sbcounty.gov/dph/flu) and select "County Testing Sites" to make an appointment or call (909) 387-3911. Additional COVID-19 testing locations are available on the website. Participants will be asked for health insurance information when registering but will never receive a bill. Participants will not be charged a co-pay nor share the cost for the test. Persons who do not have insurance or do not want to provide insurance will still be registered and tested.

Children ages three and older are eligible. A parent or guardian must accompany children under 18 years old.
