FREE COVID-19 TESTING EVENTS OFFERED IN CHINO HILLS

Chino Hills, CA – Free COVID-19 testing is easily accessible in Chino Hills through the month of March.

“We encourage our residents to take advantage of free, convenient local testing sites to help open our economy. The number of tests in a community is one of the State-imposed metrics that will help Chino Hills move to the Red Tier,” said Mayor Brian Johsz. “Getting schools and businesses reopened is vitally important and getting that to happen means we need testing to prove that we are ready to do so.”

The City of Chino Hills has partnered with San Bernardino County Public Health and Fourth District County Supervisor Curt Hagman to offer FREE COVID-19 tests in Chino Hills. Testing events are on Friday, March 5 (rescheduled from March 3), and Wednesdays, March 17 and 31. Tests will be conducted from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm inside the barn at the McCoy Equestrian & Recreation Center, 14280 Peyton Drive. Face coverings are required. A parent or guardian must accompany children under 18 years old.

COVID-19 testing is encouraged for everyone. No symptoms are required. Walk-ins will be accepted while supplies last. The County of San Bernardino will activate appointment registration for testing events approximately five to seven days before the event date. Visit www.sbcovid19.com and select “County Testing Sites” to make an appointment or call (909) 387-3911. Additional COVID-19 testing locations are available on the website. Participants will be asked for health insurance information when registering but will never receive a bill. Participants will not be charged a co-pay nor share the cost for the test. Persons who do not have insurance or do not want to provide insurance will still be registered and tested.

Another convenient FREE COVID-19 testing site is located at The Shoppes at Chino Hills, 13920 City Center Drive. The Community Testing Bus will be in the southeast parking lot

at the corner of Boys Republic Drive and Shoppes Drive from Friday, February 26 through Sunday, February 28; and from Wednesday, March 3 through Sunday, March 7. Wednesday to Sunday testing is expected to continue through the month of March with appointments being added to the website approximately seven days in advance. Appointments are recommended. Walk-ins may be accommodated while supplies last. Visit www.lhi.care/covidtesting or call (888) 634-1123 to schedule an appointment at this testing site offered through the State of California. Testing is open from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm.
