## **STUDENT MEMBER SOUGHT FOR PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION APPLICATIONS DUE APRIL 9, 2021**

Chino Hills, CA – High school students who would like to gain experience in local government are encouraged to apply to serve on the Chino Hills Parks and Recreation Commission. The Commission includes a non-voting student member who must be a Chino Hills resident attending high school on a full-time basis. The student must be a junior or senior during the 2021/2022 school year and must be in good academic standing. The Parks and Recreation Commission meets on the third Wednesday of each month at 7:00 pm. to review and discuss items relating to parks, recreation, trails, community events, wildlife preservation, and programs. Commissioners also work with community sports organizations and provide input to the design of park and recreation facilities.

Mayor Brian Johsz will interview applicants and plans to recommend an appointment to the City Council at their April 27 meeting. The new member will serve through April 30, 2022.
