FREE COVID-19 TESTING EVENTS OFFERED IN CHINO HILLS WEDNESDAYS – MARCH 17 and 31; APRIL 7 AND 21

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills continues to offer free, easily accessible COVID-19 testing to its residents through the months of March and April in partnership with San Bernardino County Public Health and Fourth District County Supervisor Curt Hagman. Testing events are on Wednesdays, March 17 and 31; April 7 and 21, from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm inside the barn at the McCoy Equestrian & Recreation Center, 14280 Peyton Drive. Face coverings are required. A parent or guardian must accompany children under 18 years old.

COVID-19 testing is encouraged for everyone. No symptoms are required. Walk-ins will be accepted while supplies last. The County of San Bernardino will activate appointment registration for testing events approximately five to seven days before the event date. Visit www.sbcovid19.com and select "County Testing Sites" to make an appointment or call (909) 387-3911. Additional COVID-19 testing locations are available on the website. Participants will be asked for health insurance information when registering but will never receive a bill. Participants will not be charged a co-pay nor share the cost for the test. Persons who do not have insurance or do not want to provide insurance will still be registered and tested.

Another convenient free COVID-19 testing site is located at The Shoppes at Chino Hills, 13920 City Center Drive. The Community Testing Bus will be in the southeast parking lot at the corner of Boys Republic Drive and Shoppes Drive Wednesdays through Sundays through the end of April (subject to change). Appointments are recommended and are added to the website approximately seven days in advance. Walk-ins may be accommodated while supplies last. Visit www.lhi.care/covidtesting or call (888) 634-1123 to schedule an appointment at this testing site offered through the State of California. Testing is open from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm.
