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## **CITY GRANTS AUTOMATIC TIME EXTENSIONS FOR ENTITLEMENT APPLICATIONS AND BUILDING PERMITS**

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills has approved temporary policies granting automatic one-year time extensions to entitlement approvals, plan check approvals, and building permits to help mitigate the economic impacts of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic on applicants, residents, and businesses in Chino Hills.

Applicants do not need to submit a request for the extensions. Automatic one-year extensions will be granted to any of the following permit types that are scheduled to expire between February 23 and December 31, 2021. Permit types eligible for the automatic one-year extensions are as follows: Conditional Use Permits, Site Plan Reviews, Minor Use Permits, Zoning Clearance Reviews, Major and Minor Variances, Tentative Maps (excluding maps for residential development extended for 18 months by Assembly Bill 1561), Building Permit Applications (excluding residential plan checks that have been extended by the State), and Building Permits (excluding residential building permits that also have been extended for 18 months by Assembly Bill 1561).

The City continues to provide streamlined, simplified services to assist businesses and residents including processing expedited, no cost temporary use permits to help move operations outdoors and waiving permit fees for temporary banners.
