## **FREE COVID-19 VACCINATION EVENTS OFFERED IN CHINO HILLS IN JUNE**

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills will host free COVID-19 vaccination events in June in partnership with San Bernardino County for all members of the community who wish to receive the vaccine. Vaccine clinics will take place on Tuesday, June 1 from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm and a week-long clinic from Monday, June 7 – Friday, June 11 from 10:00 am to 6:00 pm daily at the McCoy Equestrian & Recreation Center located at 14280 Peyton Drive. These events will be for the single dose Johnson & Johnson vaccine. The Johnson & Johnson vaccine is only approved for people ages 18 years and older.

In addition to the City vaccination events, San Bernardino County in collaboration with the Chino Valley Unified School District will host COVID-19 vaccination clinics at four local high schools including Chino Hills High School and Ruben S. Ayala High School. These events will be for the two-dose Pfizer vaccine. The Chino Hills High School clinics will take place on Tuesday, June 1 (first dose) and Tuesday, June 22 (second dose) from 2 pm – 6 pm and is located at 16150 Pomona Rincon Road. The Ruben S. Ayala High School clinic will take place on Wednesday, June 2 (first dose) and Wednesday, June 23 (second dose) from 2 pm – 6 pm located at 14255 Peyton Drive. All members of the community, including children 12 years of age and older, are eligible to receive both the first and second dose of the Pfizer vaccine free of charge. Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

Appointments are not required to receive the vaccine and walk-ins are accepted at all County-run vaccine sites. For those who wish to register for an appointment to receive the vaccine, appointments will be made available the Thursday before each event date at [MyTurn.ca.gov](https://www.myturn.ca.gov). Those who need further assistance in scheduling an appointment can call the County's COVID-19 hotline at (909) 387-3911 Monday through Friday from 9:00 am – 5:00 pm.
