CHINO HILLS KICK-STARTS SUMMER FUN WITH CONCERT AND MOVIE SERIES

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills’ popular Concerts in the Park and Movies in the Park programs will kick-start summer fun beginning in mid-June. Each program is family-friendly and free for Chino Hills residents. Advanced registration is required for some events in the series, so sign up early!

The City of Chino Hills, in collaboration with The Shoppes at Chino Hills, is excited to present the return of Concerts in the Park. The family-friendly concert series will feature seven live musical performances and kick-off on Saturday, June 19 with La Sanora Pá Gosá as a drive-in concert at the overflow parking lot located next to City Hall. Gates will open at 5:00 pm and showtime is at 7:00 pm. Reservations for tickets are now available online at www.chinohills.org/Events. Each ticket is valid for one vehicle entry and the number of passengers must not exceed the number of seatbelts in a vehicle. Ticket holders will receive vehicle directions for entry.

Concerts in the Park will return to its home at Veterans Park, located at 14877 Eucalyptus Avenue, for the City’s Independence Day celebration and concert on Saturday, July 3 from 7:00 pm to 9:15 pm. Following the Independence Day celebration concert, the remaining five concerts in the series will continue at Veterans Park every Wednesday night beginning July 14 through August 11 from 7:00 pm to 8:30 pm. Advanced registration will not be required for the Independence Day celebration or for concerts that take place at Veterans Park.

The family-friendly Movies in the Park series returns for a seven-week summertime program on Thursday evenings starting June 17 with a screening of “Onward.” Movies will be shown outdoors at the Chino Hills Community Center, located at 14250 Peyton Drive. All movies are rated PG. Gates open at 6:30 pm on the day of each showing and the movie will begin at approximately 8:00 pm. Advanced registration is required to reserve a 10’ x 10’ pod for the first movie screening and reservations are now available online at www.chinohills.org/Events. Tickets are limited to one per household and there is a maximum of six people per pod. Advanced registration and tickets will not be required for the remainder of the screenings starting with the Thursday, June 24 event date.
