Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills and Chino Hills Police Department have partnered to bring a series of free Women's Personal Safety and Awareness Workshops to the community. Women can gain the necessary knowledge, skills, and attitude to help prevent them from becoming a victim at home and while out in the community through classroom instruction and participating in tabletop scenarios led by the Chino Hills Police Department.

"We are excited to partner with our Chino Hills Police Department to bring these workshops to our community and help educate women about potentially dangerous situations and how to protect themselves," said Mayor Brian Johsz. "As a husband and father of a daughter, it is especially important to me that all women have the chance to learn these lessons on how to spot suspicious circumstances and what to do in unavoidable situations. Training like this is very valuable and I encourage ladies to sign up."

There are four workshop dates to choose from and residents are encouraged to attend any one of the workshops. The workshops will be held on Saturdays, July 31, August 28, September 25, and October 30 from 9:00 am – 11:00 am at the Chino Hills Police Department Community Room located at 14077 Peyton Drive.
