## **CITY OF CHINO HILLS MOBILE RECREATION PROGRAM RETURNS FOR THE FALL ON MONDAY, AUGUST 16**

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills free after-school Mobile Recreation program returns to neighborhoods this fall beginning Monday, August 16. The self-contained recreation vehicle will visit five different neighborhoods throughout Chino Hills to provide free, fun activities in a safe environment for children from Kindergarten through 6<sup>th</sup> grade. Kids can enjoy homework assistance, arts and crafts, sporting activities, outdoor games, board games, team building activities, and healthy snacks.

Mobile Recreation is a free program that allows children to sign themselves in and out throughout the program without a parent present, however, they must have parent consent prior to doing so and a signed emergency card on file. To participate in the program, parents will need to complete a child enrollment packet at one of the locations and times listed below. All participants are required to fill out a new enrollment packet every August. Mobile Recreation is closed on major holidays and the schedule is subject to change due to other events and/or weather conditions.
