## **FREE COVID-19 VACCINE AND FLU SHOT EVENTS IN CHINO HILLS ON TUESDAYS, DECEMBER 14 AND 21**

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills will host free COVID-19 vaccine and flu shot events in partnership with San Bernardino County on Tuesdays, December 14 and 21, from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm at the McCoy Equestrian & Recreation Center located at 14280 Peyton Drive.

The Pfizer vaccine will be available for people ages 5 and older. The Johnson & Johnson vaccine will be available for people ages 18 and older. Free flu shots are available for everyone six months of age and older. All San Bernardino County residents ages 5 and older are eligible to receive a vaccine free of charge. No insurance is necessary. Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

Booster doses of the Pfizer and Johnson & Johnson vaccine are available for everyone ages 18 and older who received the first two doses of the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine at least six months ago, and everyone ages 18 and older who received the single dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine at least two months ago.
