FREE COVID-19 VACCINE EVENTS IN CHINO HILLS EVERY TUESDAY IN JANUARY; PFIZER AND JOHNSON & JOHNSON VACCINES AVAILABLE

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills will host free COVID-19 vaccine events in partnership with San Bernardino County every Tuesday in January from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm at the McCoy Equestrian & Recreation Center located at 14280 Peyton Drive.

The Pfizer vaccine will be available for people ages 5 and older. The Johnson & Johnson vaccine will be available for people ages 18 and older. All San Bernardino County residents ages 5 and older are eligible to receive a vaccine free of charge. No insurance is necessary. Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

Booster doses of the Pfizer vaccine are available for everyone ages 16 and older who received the first two doses of the Pfizer vaccine at least six months ago. Booster doses of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine are available to everyone ages 18 and older who received the single dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine at least two months ago. Appointments will be made available the Thursday before each event date at MyTurn.ca.gov. Appointments are encouraged; however, walk-ins will be accepted.
