## **FREE COVID-19 ANTIGEN (RAPID) TEST KITS AVAILABLE TO CHINO HILLS RESIDENTS AT DRIVE-THRU EVENTS – ADVANCED REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED**

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills has partnered with San Bernardino County to provide free COVID-19 Antigen (rapid) test kits to Chino Hills residents. Advanced registration is required to reserve the test kits for pick-up at drive-thru events on either Tuesday, February 1 or Thursday, February 3. Residents will be able to select an available date and time window when registering to pick-up their tests at a City facility. The pick-up location and address will be provided to the recipient on their receipt once the registration is complete.

Registration for residents opens on Friday, January 28 at 9:00 am online at [www.chinohills.org/RecOnline](http://www.chinohills.org/RecOnline) under activity code 304006. There is a limit of one registration per household. One registration includes two kits. Each kit has two tests for a total of four tests per household. Due to the increased demand for testing, please be sure to register early. Residents are encouraged to create an online account or confirm their existing login information, including username and password, is active in advance of the registration date. For assistance with online registration or creating an account, please call the Recreation Office at (909) 364-2700.

Registration will be done entirely online, there will be no in-person registration available at the Government Center or the Chino Hills Community Center. Test kits were made available in advance to the City's high-risk and vulnerable populations including senior groups. For residents who do not have access to the internet or website to reserve tests, please contact the Recreation Office at (909) 364-2700 for assistance if test kits are available at the time of the call.

Every home in the United States is also eligible to order four free at-home COVID-19 tests mailed directly to their home from the Federal Government online at [COVIDtests.gov](http://COVIDtests.gov).
