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CITY EXTENDS AUTOMATIC TIME EXTENSIONS FOR ENTITLEMENT APPLICATIONS AND BUILDING PERMITS

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills has extended temporary policies granting an additional automatic six-month time extension to certain entitlement approvals, plan check approvals, and building permits to help mitigate the economic impacts of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic on applicants, residents, and businesses in Chino Hills.

In February 2021, the City previously granted automatic one-year time extensions for entitlement applications and building permits set to expire between February 23 and December 31, 2021. On February 22, 2022, the City granted an additional automatic six-month time extension to any of the following permit types that are scheduled to expire between February 22 and June 30, 2022:

Conditional Use Permits, Site Plan Reviews, Minor Use Permits, Zoning Clearance Reviews, Major and Minor Variances, Tentative Maps (excluding maps for residential development extended for 18 months by Assembly Bill 1561), Building Permit Applications (excluding residential plan checks that have been extended by the State), and Building Permits (excluding residential building permits that also have been extended for 18 months by Assembly Bill 1561).
