2022 WATER CONSERVATION POSTER CONTEST WINNERS HONORED

Chino Hills, CA – The Chino Hills City Council honored 12 winners of the City’s 21st Annual Water Conservation Design-a-Sign Contest during its April 26 Council Meeting. The contest encourages students in Chino Hills from kindergarten through 12th grade to design posters promoting water conservation in conjunction with Water Awareness Month in May.

This year’s theme was “How We Save Water During a Drought.” 12 winners were recognized for their exceptional artwork from 410 submitted entries. The winning posters will be converted into street signs and installed on streetlight poles along City Center Drive at the Chino Hills Government Center. Eventually, the street signs will be moved and installed in different parks throughout the City.

Judges awarded prizes to the first, second, and third place winners in each age category. First place winners received a Kids Edition Fire Tablet for the Kindergarten age group, a \$100 Amazon gift card for the 1st - 3rd grade and 4th – 6th grade age groups, and an HP Chromebook for the 7th the 12th grade age group. All second and third place winners from each age category received both a \$30 gift card to Harkins Theaters and a \$20 Chick-fil-A gift card. This contest relies on the support of Chino Hills schools and classroom teachers. A plaque was awarded to classrooms with the highest participation in each of the age categories. Rolling Ridge Elementary School was recognized for the highest participation in all three elementary school age groups and Ruben S. Ayala High School was recognized for the highest participation in the 7th – 12th grade age group. There were 12 classrooms with 100 percent participation that were entered in a raffle for a chance to win a \$100 Hobby Lobby gift card. Mrs. Martinez from Oak Ridge Elementary School won the raffle.

The contest judges included Parks and Recreation Commissioner Samantha James-Perez, multiple representatives from area water agencies, and City staff.
