## **CHINO HILLS MAYOR RAY MARQUEZ AND COUNCIL MEMBER CYNTHIA MORAN RECOGNIZED FOR LEADERSHIP ACHIEVEMENT BY LEAGUE OF CALIFORNIA CITIES**

Chino Hills, CA – Chino Hills Mayor Ray Marquez and Council Member Cynthia Moran were recognized by the League of California Cities (Cal Cities) for successfully completing the Leadership in Action level of the Cal Cities prestigious Torch Program. Mayor Marquez and Council Member Moran were two of seven mayors and councilmembers recognized this year for the Leadership in Action level at the Cal Cities Annual Conference in Long Beach on Friday, September 9.

The Leadership in Action level is the highest level obtained in the Cal Cities Academy through their educational program for mayors and council members who are seeking to continue professional development and enhance their knowledge and skills to better serve the public. Individuals being recognized at the Leadership in Action level have completed everything at the Advanced Leadership level, have served at least five years as a City elected official, have completed at least five Cal Cities conferences, and have participated in at least five Cal Cities and non-Cal Cities leadership activities.

Established in 1898, the League of California Cities, later renamed Cal Cities, is a nonprofit statewide association that advocates for cities with the state and federal governments and provides education and training services to elected and appointed city officials.
