RESIDENTS ARE INVITED TO APPLY FOR MULTIPLE CITY OF CHINO HILLS COMMISSION POSITIONS BY THURSDAY, DECEMBER 22

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills is now accepting applications for multiple seats on its three different commissions: Parks & Recreation, Planning, and Public Works. City Commissions serve as advisory boards to the City Council on matters pertaining to parks projects, new developments, recreation programs, traffic safety, infrastructure improvements, and more. Applications will be accepted until 5:30 pm on Thursday, December 22. Applicants must be of voting age and a resident of Chino Hills.

City Commissioners are appointed by a nominating City Council Member and affirmed by a majority vote of the City Council. Each City Council Member is responsible for appointing one member to each of the three commissions. Commission members serve a term that coincides with the term of their nominating council member. Mayor Peter Rogers and Council Members Brian Johsz and Ray Marquez, who were re-elected to the Chino Hills City Council in November, are seeking applications for all three commissions. Terms of current appointees expired November 30. Previous Commissioners appointed by Mayor Rogers and Council Members Johsz and Marquez must reapply if they are interested in continuing their service.

Applications and more information on each of the commissions and their respective responsibilities is available online at www.chinohills.org/CommissionApplication and in the City Clerk's Office on the second floor of Chino Hills City Hall. Interviews may be scheduled at the Council Member's discretion. Council Members expect to make their nominations at the January 10 Council Meeting. Nominees must then be affirmed by a majority vote of the full City Council. The new commissioners' terms will be effective through the end of their appointing Council Member's term which is November 30, 2026.
