PUBLIC WORKS OPEN HOUSE AT CITY HALL ON MAY 24

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills invites residents to learn more about the Public Works Department and their role in the City's operations during an open house event on Wednesday, May 24 from 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm. The event will take place prior to the City of Chino Hills Council Meeting in the roundabout outside City Hall, located at 14000 City Center Drive.

The Public Works Department has operational and maintenance responsibility for water and sewer service, streets, parks, medians, slopes, open space, trees, graffiti removal, facilities, street sweeping, and storm drains. The City's equipment and devices are operated by highly skilled professionals who consider safety their highest priority. Public Works professionals will be on hand to answer questions regarding City projects, including their design and construction, as well as other services they perform daily.

Several large pieces of equipment will be on display to highlight a few of the many tools which are needed to keep the water flowing, the toilets flushing, the traffic moving, and the parks ready for enjoyment. Children will enjoy being up close with the City's boom truck and new remote-control mower. A hydro excavator truck, pothole patch truck, and the sanitation camera truck, which inspects sewer pipes, will be on-site as well. A large water model will also be on display to demonstrate how rainwater is stored in the underground aquifer. The Engineering Division will also be on-site to share how the City keeps Chino Hills safe and environmentally friendly for residents.
