PHASE 2 OF COMMUNITY PARK REHABILITATION PROJECT NOW COMPLETE, PHASE 3 BEGINS SEPTEMBER 2023

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills is excited to announce that Phase 2 of the Community Park Rehabilitation Project, which began in March 2023, is now complete. This was the second phase of a long-term improvement plan which includes three phases of work to improve turf conditions on all ball fields, enhance the overall appearance of the park, and create additional parking within the facility. Phase 3 will begin in September 2023 and the overall project is expected to be complete in summer of 2024.

Phase 2 work included assembling new portable baseball and softball fencing and repairing and replacing electrical outlets as needed. Phase 3 will include installing a new water bottle refill station near the snack bar, revamping ball fields 5 and 6 by replacing the artificial turf in the outfields and converting the infields to artificial turf, repairing park landscaping, and exploring the feasibility of new digital LED scoreboards and new LED lighting on all six fields.

Phase 3 will also include resurfacing and restriping of the parking lot as well as expansion of the existing parking lot by paving the grass area located at the west corner of the park near the Eucalyptus Loop trailhead to accommodate additional parking. Plans are also being designed to explore the feasibility of creating additional parking in the southwest side of the park in the grass area located within the existing parking lot north of Peyton Drive.

During this time, partial park, field, and parking lot closures will be in place to complete the improvements. Fields 5 and 6 will be unavailable for use November 6, 2023, through February 2, 2024, to complete the turf renovation, unless weather causes delays. Fields 1 through 4 will remain available for allocated use during this time. Restriping and expansion of the parking lot will begin in April 2024. Closures and dates of each phase may adjust due to weather conditions, availability of supplies, or construction delays.
