26TH ANNUAL CELEBRATE THE FAMILY POSTER AND ESSAY CONTEST ENTRIES ARE DUE BY FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 29

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills invites young artists from kindergarten through sixth grade, and essay writers in seventh and eighth grade, to submit entries for the 26th Annual [Celebrate the Family Poster and Essay Contest](#). The theme this year is “This is Why I love My Family.” The contest is open to students in kindergarten through eighth grade who live in Chino Hills or attend school in Chino Hills. Prizes will be awarded to the first, second, and third place winners in each age category.

Two categories are available for entries based on the child’s grade level. Students in kindergarten through sixth grade may submit a poster drawing using hand-applied mediums such as crayons, paint, pencils, or pens. Poster entries must be submitted on the City’s 11”x17” poster entry form available online for printing, or to be picked-up at the Chino Hills Community Center. Students in seventh and eighth grade may submit an essay that is one-page, typed, and double-spaced.

Entries must be submitted in-person to the Chino Hills Community Center, located at 14250 Peyton Drive, by 4:00 pm on Friday, September 29. Winners will be recognized at the Tuesday, November 14 City Council meeting. Contest winners will also be invited to an Artist Reception at the Community Center on Thursday, November 30.
