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CITY OF CHINO HILLS ADDS THREE NEW BIKE REPAIR STATIONS ACROSS CITY

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills has completed the installation of three new bike repair stations strategically located across the City, bringing the total count of bike repair stations to four in Chino Hills. These additions aim to enhance the cyclists' experience in Chino Hills, providing them with readily available resources for quick and efficient bike repairs.

The bike repair stations are situated at key locations across Chino Hills including:

1. Chino Hills Community Center, at the corner of Peyton Drive and Eucalyptus Avenue
2. Grand Avenue Park, off Grand Avenue, east of the Park entrance
3. Chino Hills State Park, off Elinvar Drive at the State Park entrance
4. Meadows Park, along Butterfield Ranch Road (originally installed in November 2022)

The decision to expand the bike repair station initiative was fueled by the positive response received after the installation of the first station at Meadows Park. The City collected feedback from a survey to assess the functionality of the stations, and the need for additional stations

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and desired locations throughout the City the community would most benefit from. Each of the four bike repair stations is fully equipped with a comprehensive set of tools, ensuring cyclists have access to equipment they need for on-the-go repairs.

The tools available at each station include:

- Philips and flat head screwdrivers
- Allen wrenches (2.5, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8mm)
- Box wrenches (8, 9, 10, 11, 15, 32mm)
- Tire levers
- Bike pump

The total project cost for the four bike repair stations was \$13,100. Of the total project cost, \$10,000 was provided by a generous donation from the Chino Hills Community Foundation, and \$3,100 was funded by the City’s General Fund.
