In consideration for being permitted to participate in the event/class/activity/program, I hereby agree, for myself, my heirs, administrators, executors and assigns, that I shall indemnify and hold harmless the Released Parties from any and all claims, demands, actions, or suits arising out of or in connection with my participation and/or my minor child's participation in the event/class/activity/program. I agree to be professionally photographed or videotaped, and/or agree to have my child professionally photographed or videotaped, and release the use of the photographs or videos for publicity in City of Chino Hills publications and other public information tools. I hereby consent to treatment and all medical care deemed necessary for me or my minor child as a result of accident or injury. I further agree to pay any and all costs incurred as a result of said treatment. The City reserves the right to immediately unenroll any child who has had a history of discipline/suspension/expulsion in any recreational programs, and who exhibits disruptive conduct. By participating in this event/class/activity/program, I voluntarily assume all risks to potential exposures and agree to voluntarily follow all related public health directives.

PARTICIPANT RULES AND PROVISIONS

The Chino Hills Mobile Recreation program provides recreation programming for children who are in kindergarten-6th grade. Program participants will enjoy a variety of recreational and enrichment activities, sports, and homework help.

I agree to adhere to the following program rules:

1. All participating children must have an Emergency Card on file and will need to submit a new one at the start of each school year to remain enrolled in the program. Participants may sign themselves in and out each time of attendance using their first and last name.
2. Mobile Recreation is a drop in/out program and children are allowed to sign themselves in and out of the program without a parent/guardian present however, they must have parent consent prior to doing so. This is a non-parent participation program.
3. Mobile Recreation will be canceled due to inclement weather and on major holidays. The status of the program can be checked at any time by calling the Field Conditions Hotline at (909) 364-2738.
4. All members, parents, and guardians are expected to be respectful to staff, volunteers, participants, parents, property, equipment, and facilities. Failure to adhere to the aforementioned may result in your child's suspension and/or expulsion from the program.
5. Property such as cell phones, airpods, and hand held video games must remain inside the child's backpack during program hours.
6. Skateboards, scooters, skates, and bikes are not to be used during program hours.
7. The City of Chino Hills is not responsible for lost, stolen, damage, or misplaced items brought to program.
8. Aggressive/physical behavior, bullying, foul language and public displays of affection (PDA) will not be tolerated at any school, park, or facility. Failure to adhere may result in discipline, suspension, and/or expulsion from the program.
9. Participants will be expected to follow program rules at all times. Positive reinforcement methods will be used by our staff to promote acceptable behavior. The following will be enforced if behavior problems occur with your child. Staff will document student's inappropriate behavior, with either a "Self Reflection Form" or a "Behavior Report," depending on the severity of the issue. If a participant breaks the rules, children will be redirected, the behavior will be addressed with a staff member and positive alternatives will be discussed. The participant may lose program privileges depending on the situation. More serious incidents will require immediate parent/guardian notification and parents/guardians may be required to pick up the child early from program. Continued/Severe inappropriate behavior, may result in suspension from the program and in some cases, dismissal from the program, based on severity of the situation as deemed by the Program Coordinator.
10. Beginning five minutes after the end of program time each day, participants who are still at Mobile Recreation will be charged \$1/per minute late fee. After one hour, if your child has not been picked up, the Chino Hills Police Department will be contacted and your child will be released into their custody. The Chino Hills Police Department can be reached at (909) 364-2000; 14077 Peyton Drive, Chino Hills.

I have read all of the above rules and have discussed them with my child. I understand repeated infractions of these rules may result in my child's suspension from the City sponsored Mobile Recreation Program.
