The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) and the USDA Forest Service (Forest Service) are preparing an Environmental Impact Report / Environmental Impact Statement (EIR/EIS) for the proposed Tehachapi Renewable Transmission Project. The proposed project would include a series of new and upgraded high-voltage electric transmission lines and substations to deliver electricity generated from new renewable energy projects. During the scoping period for the EIR/EIS, the City of Chino Hills proposed an alternative route through the area, which involves re-routing a transmission line through Chino Hills State Park and the construction of a new switching station in the Park. Three other alternatives have subsequently been developed, all of which affect lands within the Park to some degree. The CPUC and the Forest Service will hold a public meeting at the following time and location to obtain input from the public on alternative routes for the proposed transmission upgrades in the Chino Hills area:
